B. CONVENTIONAL (NON-DIGITAL LEARNING)


1. Modular session - Module (e.g. My Distance Learning Buddy Module) is the main basis of the discussion based on the most essential learning competencies.



GENERAL INFORMATION

History of **SAINT CATHERINE'S ACADEMY:** CENTER OF CATHOLIC EDUCATION INC

Saint Catherine's Academy is an Archdiocesan co-educational Catholic school, owned and operated by the Archdiocese of San Fernando, Pampanga. It is located in Porac, Pampanga as the first non-stock, non-profit co-educational sectarian school established by Fr. Santiago Blanco, O.S.A. in 1951 beside Saint Catherine of Alexandria Parish.

In April 1961, SCA:CCEI received recognition from the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) and initially offered secondary education alongside with pre-school and elementary education in 1955. Subsequently, as it continues to offer quality education certified by the Private Education Assistance Committee – Fund for Assistance to Private Education (PEAC-FAPE) on February 1, 2015, scholarship grants have been given to deserving students with the amount of 9,000.00. On the same year on November 24, it was permitted to operate Senior High school with the voucher of 80% (from the private) and 100% (from the public).

At present, with the directives of the present director Rev. Fr. Elmer G. Dizon, Saint Catherine's Academy is a member of the Archdiocese of San Fernando Educational System (ASFES) and Catholic Educational Association of the Philippines (CEAP). The director has adopted Dynamic Learning Program in the Intermediate and High school levels and currently adopting the blended learning in this time of pandemic.

In the exercise of its functions and mandated tasks as a Catholic institution, SCA:CCEI is guided by its Vision-Mission-Goals through constant recognition, practice of core values and sacramental programs.

ADMISSION REGULATIONS

The applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1.1 Kindergarten
 - a. Must be at least 5 years old not later than October 31
 - b. Photocopy: Birth/Baptismal Certificate
- 1.2 Grade one
 - a. Must be at least 6 years old with Kindergarten background
 - b. Card from the principal of the Kindergarten school where the child studied
 - c. Must pass oral/written exams
 - d. Photocopy: Birth/Baptismal Certificate
- 1.3 Transferees (Including Grade 7 and Grade 11)
 - a. Report Card/Form 137-A
 - b. Letter of Recommendation from Principal, Adviser or Guidance Counselor
 - c. Honorable Dismissal
 - d. Testing Fee
 - e. Must pass the interview and written examinations
 - f. Photocopy: Birth/Baptismal/Confirmation Certificate

Note: The following will not be admitted in SCA: (Grade/High School Transferees)

- a. Students with failing grades.
- b. Students who were dropped from other schools for grievous offenses.
- c. Repeaters due to academic failure
- d. Irregular students

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Step 1: Get an application form for entrance examination at Registrar's Office and fill it up.
- Step 2: Pay the entrance fee P200 at the Cashier's Office.
- Step 3: Take the exam at the given date: present your receipt.
- Step 4: Visit the school after one week for the result.

Dynamic Learning Program(DLP)

DLP Components are

1. Parallel Classes
All sections of each year level have the same subject at the same time.
2. Activity-based Multi-domain Learning
Classes begin with the expert teacher who usually flashes through a projector/LED TV a learning activity sheet which includes concept notes, exercises, dills, drawings, themes and essays which are handwritten by the students on the Learning Activity Sheets.
3. In-school Comprehensive Student Portfolio
(instead of notebooks)
All daily activities including quizzes and exams are compiled in the in-school comprehensive student portfolios.
4. Strategic Study / Rest Periods.
Strategic Studies are during Wednesdays. The MAPEH teachers will lead the exercises and practicum -supervising certain activities like playing, cooking, painting, rosary making, lantern making, etc.

Culminating activities are set every Wednesdays. From Monday to Friday, students answer simple, attainable specific activity sheets. The policy behind is the learning by doing, discovery approach, problem solving and active not passive learning. The designs of learning activities are concept notes (introductory material), example/ illustration, vocabulary words, and questions problems or exercises.
